

The table of contents and abstracts of the newly released [3/2019 issue](#) of the four-monthly journal [Economia&Lavoro](#) are now available on [Fondazione Giacomo Brodolini](#)'s website. Single essays in electronic format, and paper copies of the present issue can be [purchased online](#).

The issue opens with a **monographic section**, introduced by **Sebastiano Fadda**, consisting of four papers presented at the conference “**Technology, Employment and Labour Market Institutions**”, organised by the Association for Interdisciplinary Research on Labour (ASTRIL) in December 2018. The essay by **Giorgio Colacchio** and **Guglielmo Forges Davanzati** provides a reference framework for the interpretation of the **causes and consequences of wage moderation in Italy**. **Natalia Faraoni**, **Tommaso Ferraresi**, and **Nicola Sciclone** carry out a detailed analysis of the **skills required in relation to the development of production systems of the so-called “Fourth Industrial Revolution”**, and compare such skills with the competences and skills of the employed population. The contribution by **Pietro Checcucci** focuses on the problematic relationship between digital innovation and employability of older workers, providing an interpretation of ongoing transformations, as well as an explanation of the current Italian scenario. Finally, **Massimo De Minicis**, **Silvia Donà**, **Nicola Lettieri**, and **Manuel Marocco** deal with **protection measures for gig-economy workers**, tabling a proposal in this regard.

Next is the contribution by **Matteo Gaddi**, **Francesco Garibaldo**, and **Matteo Rinaldini**, which builds on and deepens the main findings of a research project implemented by Fondazione Giuseppe Di Vittorio and Fondazione Claudio Sabattini on the **FCA-CNH Group**.

The issue ends with **Francesco Pastore**'s essay, which provides a review of the (mainly Italian) literature evaluating the **impact of the Youth Guarantee programme** implemented in Italy in the last five years or so.
